Approved at 2023 Annual Meeting.

The verbatim language was previously provided. However, this is a brief summary of the proposed changes to the By-Laws.

1. Initiation Fees have been deleted. All new owners/members will be required to pay a \$750 transfer fee. Existing homeowners that have never paid the initiation fee will also be required to pay the transfer fee to become members in the future.

Note: Currently there are only 11 of the 164 homes that never paid an initiation fee.

- 2. Board of Director positions are defined and now include a Membership Director which has proven to be valuable in the record keeping of members.
- 3. Proxies will be allowed. The BOD assumes they will be used minimally but will allow for members who are ill, absentee owners or have scheduling conflicts to still participate in a vote.
- 4. Electronic banking language included now that it is more common for payments to be made in means other than a paper check.
- 5. The Treasurer will be able to make a payment without a cosignature if it is within the approved budget.
- 6. Any surplus funds at year end are now deemed to be moved to the operating budget or reserves for the next fiscal year, as deemed necessary by the BOD.
